

1- When does the school open?

Answer: The start and end times of classes vary each academic year. For this reason, students should follow the academic calendar for each year on the university website.

2- What is the exemption exam and when is it held?

Answer: In order to be exempt from the compulsory English and/or Computer courses, an English and Computer exemption exam is held at the beginning of each semester. Students who want to be exempt from these courses must take these two exams and get 60 points out of 100.

3- Is it compulsory to attend classes?

Answer: Yes, attendance is compulsory.

4- How many hours/day is the right of absence?

Answer: Students who attend compulsory or elective courses must attend at least 70% of each of the courses they take. In this context, attendance is compulsory for 5 weeks out of an average of 8 weeks per semester. Students who are absent for more than 5 weeks fail the course they are absent from.

5- Attendance is semester or yearly?

Answer: Absenteeism is calculated on a semester basis.

6- Can we take exams if we fail due to absenteeism?

Answer: It is at the discretion of the instructor who gives the course for the students who are absent to take the exams and leave the exams successfully.
